

164 HOURS LOST TO CONGESTION ANNUALLY

Environmental Factors

- Increased traffic congestion
- Recruitment challenges
- 1st mile/last mile deficiencies

Development Changes

- Moves from suburban to urban
- Lack of capacity to continue developing
- New urban cores outside of Boston CBD




Decentralization

- Lack of stable funding model
- Control of TDM moving to local level
- Greater participation among communities

TMA STATE FUNDING

- Grant programs through DOT (CMAQ)
- DOER Grants (1990's)
- TDM/TMA Assistance Program (1995)
- Community Innovative Challenge Grants (A&F)
- Current grant funding program (Workforce Transit Grant, 2019)




